The organ in St Patrick's chapel, Dilworth School was originally gifted by Old Boys in 1956 to mark the golden jubilee of the school and in honour of Old Boys and staff who gave their lives in two world wars. The Croft organ, installed 50 years ago, was by 2000 in dire need of a major refit and updating of the old technology and worn-out parts.

The 3 manual pipe organ has been reinstalled after a major overhaul by the South Island Organ Company, with the addition of the latest technical playing aids and a new Antiphonal division.

The organ is arranged in three sections. The Great and Swell are situated in the North chambers, on the left of the Chancel; the Choir, with some of the Pedal division is situated on the South side of the chancel with the console; and the stunning-looking Antiphonal, with horizontal fanfare trumpets, is set against the tall West windows of the chapel.
